Formation of CTTE

Need:

- Promote Industrial Arts Education

Organized May 1950 at the AIAA Conference

- Called American Council on Industrial Arts Teacher Education (ACIATE)
- Two programs Identified by John A. Whitesel, Miami University (OH)

First Program Presenters

1951 ACIATE Program

- Accreditation of Industrial Arts Teacher Education Programs

Yearbook Series Started After the 1951 Conference

- William McKnight

1952 ACIATE Program

- Graduate work for Industrial Arts Teacher Education

1953-55 AIAA Conference

- ACIATE equal billing in Program as AIAA
- Discussion topics included:
 - 1953 Selecting Industrial Arts Teachers
 - 1954 Supervisory Practices in Industrial Teacher Education
 - 1955 Influences on Industrial Arts Teacher Education

ACIATE Billing at 1957 AIAA Conference

- 1957
 - AIAA major billing with 11 programs
 - ACIATE & ACIAS equal billing
 - ACIATE had 7 programs
- Continued until 1976

No Billing in 1977

- For either ACIAS & ACIATE
- ACIATE very active and supported AIAA

Name Change in 1986

- Council on Technology Teacher Education (CTTE)
- Made change after AIAA changed name to ITEA
- Became a Council member of the ITEA

Goals

Goals Essentially the Same Throughout History

- Support and further the professional ideas of teacher education
- Define and strive to achieve the purposes and professional goals of teacher education
- Stimulate research and dissemination information of professional interest

Council Structure

Within CTTE

- Five elected officers
 - President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Past President
 - President becomes the Past President
 - Each officer has assigned duties and committees
- Use to have an appointed Membership Secretary
