

CTTE Outstanding Research Award

Call for Nominations

The CTTE sponsors an annual award for outstanding scholarly research in the field of technology teacher education. This award is presented to a member or members of the CTTE who have provided significant service to the profession through research and related scholarship in the preparation of technology education teachers or enhancement of professional practice in technology education. The CTTE *Outstanding Research Award* will consist of a framed award certificate and a monetary award of \$1,000. Recipients of the award are asked to submit a manuscript of their work to the *Journal of Technology Education*.

NOMINATION PROCESS:

Candidates for the *Outstanding Research Award* self-nominate themselves for consideration through an application process implemented by the CTTE Research Committee. The process consists of an initial screening based on a brief abstract and a peer review of papers submitted by selected finalists. The CTTE *Outstanding Research Award* is available on an annual basis, but will not be awarded if submissions are not deemed worthy of the award after being reviewed by the Research Committee.

STEPS FOR NOMINATION:

1. Complete the attached *Outstanding Research Award* self-nomination form. It is also available on the CTTE web site or from the chairperson of the CTTE Research Committee. Persons conducting nominated research projects must be members of CTTE.
2. Attach a copy of the manuscript or a 1,200-word abstract of the scholarly work to be considered. This should include statements of the title, significance, problem, research methods, findings, conclusions, and recommendations. For research not yet completed, anticipated findings, conclusions, and recommendations can be suggested, but the focus should be on the planned design of the research.
3. The self-nomination form and manuscript or abstract should be submitted to the chairperson of the CTTE Research Committee. These materials must arrive by **December 15, 2003**.
4. Based on review of self-nomination form and manuscript or abstract, up to three finalists will be selected for further consideration to receive the *Outstanding Research Award*. Finalists will be asked to submit completed papers reporting the results of their research no later than **January 15, 2004**.
5. Finalists will be invited to present the results of their research at a CTTE Research Committee sponsored session during the ITEA conference. The *Outstanding Research Award* will be presented to the selected recipient during the CTTE Business Meeting at the ITEA conference.
