

CALL for NOMINATIONS

The Silvius-Wolansky Award Outstanding Scholarly Publication in Technology Education

The *Silvius-Wolansky Award* for the Outstanding Scholarly Publication in Technology Education is co-sponsored by the G. Harold Silvius Foundation and the Council on Technology Teacher Education. The award is presented annually by the CTTE to an author (or co-authors) whose scholarship has enhanced the Technology Education profession.

Criteria for Eligibility

1. The manuscript being nominated should make a significant contribution to Technology Education in one or more areas such as curriculum development, teaching methodology, etc.
2. The scholarly work must be an article, research report, chapter, monograph, or book published within the two calendar years preceding the nomination deadline.
3. The nominee(s) must hold a full-time assignment at an accredited college or university, where he/she/they is/are working in Technology Teacher Education.
4. The individual(s) must be nominated by a person in Technology Education. On jointly authored manuscripts the authors should be nominated as a group. Self-nominations are also welcomed.
5. An individual may receive the award no more than once in any five-year period.

Procedures for Nomination and Selection of the Award Recipient

1. The nominee shall mail the following materials by January 15 to the CTTE Publications Committee Chairperson: Mark Sanders, Technology Education, 144 Smyth Hall, Virginia Tech, Blacksburg, VA 24061-0432, 540-231-8173(p), 231-4188(fax), msanders@vt.edu.
 - a. Five copies of the manuscript being nominated (Note: If the publication is available online, provide the electronic address instead. If it is a book or monograph, check with the CTTE Publications Committee Chair to see if one copy will be sufficient).
 - b. A one-page rationale that addresses the significance of the publication.
2. Selection will be made by a sub-committee of the CTTE Publications Committee.
3. Publications nominated for this award will be judged by the following criteria:
 - a. Originality of the contribution
 - b. Quality of the contribution
 - c. Content and clarity of purpose
 - d. Organization and presentation
 - e. Potential impact on the profession
4. The recipient of the award will be notified in February and invited to the annual conference of the International Technology Education Association, where the award will be presented.
